Dear Half Moon Bay Registrants,

We received correspondence that the State of California will not be granting any permits for the next 30 days, putting the health of our community first. We will be rescheduling the 2020 Half Moon Bay Triathlon for May, June or July of this year. We will not know of a new date until the beginning of April, but will be in touch once we have determined the best date that doesn't impact holidays or other events. If the new date doesn't work with people's schedule once announced, we will then follow our Transfer, Credit and Deferral policies for those that can't make it. <http://usapevents.com/event-policies/>

Currently, all USA Productions events are still scheduled to occur, but we will need to work around this situation and keep our community in mind first. We will be in communication regularly to make sure everyone is aware and informed of any changes to our upcoming events and the new date for the Half Moon Bay Triathlon.

- Sanitization zones around each event area. Transition, Finish, Venue, Porto Toilets and Expo
- Disinfectant spray bottles and wipes in each porta toilet unit, will have one person managing this to make sure they stay clean and supplies are replenished in all areas.
- Extra sinks and disinfectant hand wipes available outside of Porto Toilet areas
- Staff and Volunteers to use nitrile gloves around each aid station and food locations
- We will ask those that are sick to stay home and get well
